

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Central Himalayan Rural Action Group ([Chirag](#)) is looking to hire a Medical professional to guide and manage Chirag Hospital and also provide inputs to the organization's preventive health programme. Chirag hospital was established in 2009 with the aim of providing primary health care to communities located in rural Kumaun. Facilities at the hospital include a well equipped laboratory, an X-ray facility, an ECG machine, treatment rooms, a delivery room, a general ward with six beds and two private rooms. Presently, the hospital has 4 doctors (2 full time and 2 visiting) and is supported by a staff of 8 members. Chirag's preventive health programme aims to support and strengthen existing government efforts under National Rural Health Mission.



Required Qualifications

- Applicant **must be a MBBS** from a recognized institution with over 20 years of experience. Preference would be given to applicants with specialized degrees.
- Applicant must be willing to reside and work in rural Himalayas.
- Applicants who have demonstrated leadership skills in their past assignments will be given preference. Preference would also be given to applicants who have served in the Armed Forces
- Previous experience of working with rural communities would be a bonus
